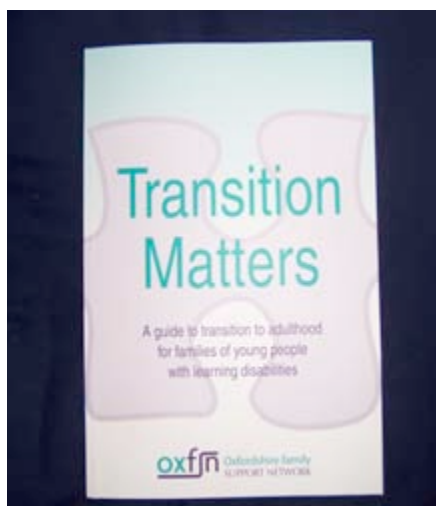


# "Transition Matters" workshops
